Mode 2	Sleep or ON	Sleep or ON	1. Interval time is arrive 2. SOS alert	[10-60] minutes	Base on the configuration it may: 1. GPS or TCP will resume if device wake up 2. GPS or TCP may always ON
Mode 3	Sleep	Sleep	1. Interval time is arrive 2. SOS alert	[1-24] hours	GPS and TCP will resume if device wake up <i>* MODE 3 is highly recommended if you need to extend the battery life for 12 months.</i>

When device is vibrate it will run as T1 and when device detect to still it will run as T2. <i>* MODE 7 is an optimized version based on MODE 0, with lower power consumption than MODE 0</i>
Mode 0	Sleep or ON	Sleep or ON	1. Interval time is arrive 2. Vibrate 3. SOS alert	T1 is [10-600] <b>seconds</b> T2 is [1-24] hours	1. T1 is [10-600] <b>seconds</b> , T2 is [1-24] hours; 2. When device is vibrate it will run as T1 and when device detect to still it will run as T2. <i>* MODE 0 is mix mode of Mode 3 and mode 4</i>
Mode 8	Sleep or ON	Sleep or ON	1. Outdoor & Vibrate 2. SOS alert	[10-60] <b>seconds</b>	When device is indoors it will go to sleep, and when device is outdoors and continue to move it will report at T interval and T is [10-60] seconds. <i>* MODE 8 is highly recommended for Pet Tracking.</i>
Mode 9	Sleep or ON	Sleep or ON	1. Interval time is arrive 2. Vibrate 3. SOS alert	T1 is [10-1440] <b>minutes</b> T2 is [1-24] hours	1. T1 is [10-1440] <b>minutes</b> , T2 is [1-24] hours; 2. When device is vibrate it will run as T1 and when device detect to still it will run as T2. <i>* The only difference between MODE 7 and MODE 9 is: MODE 7 prioritizes GPS positioning, while MODE 9 prioritizes WIFI positioning.</i>
Mode 10	Sleep	Sleep	1. Interval time is arrive 2. SOS alert	T1 is [0,23] <b>hours</b> T2 is [00:00,23:59] <b>HH:MM</b>	1. T1 is [0,23] <b>hours</b> , T2 is [00:00,23:59] <b>HH:MM</b> . T2 is UTC time 2. <i>After setting the alarm clock parameter, the device will automatically generate multiple sub-alarms and limit them to 24 hours according to the value set in T1. If the T1 is 0, it means that only one report will be generated per day.</i>
